

115 年台灣擬真醫學教育學會多元醫療人才培育與擬真教育國際年會 暨第六屆第二次會員大會

➤**主題：**深耕多元人才培訓·鏈結國際：擬真引領醫療教育新未來

➤**核心理念：**

本次年會以深耕計畫範疇二「規劃多元人才培訓」為核心，透過擬真醫學教育建構跨專業、多層級及多元職能之人才培育模式，並結合人工智慧、虛擬實境及數位科技等創新工具，提升醫療專業人員之臨床能力、團隊合作、問題解決及病人安全能力。同時透過國際交流與合作，參考 AMEE 在醫學教育、教師培育與教育創新，以及 ISQua 在醫療品質、病人安全與品質改善之國際發展趨勢，建立「人才培育、教育創新、臨床能力、病人安全、國際接軌」之完整發展架構。

➤**目的：**

本學會年會與專科護理師及護理師擬真情境競賽同日於臺北榮民總醫院致德樓併行舉辦，透過學術研討、擬真情境競賽及成果展示等多元形式，建構跨專業、跨領域之醫療人才培訓與交流平台。本研討會以「多元人才培育」為核心，展現臺灣健康照護機構不同專業醫事人員如何運用擬真醫學教育，將臨床技能訓練與實務情境相互結合，培養醫療人員之臨床判斷、溝通協調、團隊合作及問題解決能力。同時，本研討會將擬真教育延伸至病人安全文化、團隊資源管理、醫療品質提升、臨床實務應用及醫療人員復原力等面向，透過跨專業學習與實務經驗分享，促進不同醫事職類間之交流與合作，強化多元醫療人才之專業能力與團隊協作能力。另外，藉由學術研討會、擬真情境競賽及研究成果展現，建立「人才培育、教育創新、臨床實務、病人安全與品質改善」之連結，並拓展國內外擬真醫學教育交流與合作，提升臺灣擬真醫學教育之發展與國際能見度。誠摯歡迎各醫療及健康照護相關專業人員踴躍參與學會競賽、學術投稿及成果交流，共同推動臺灣多元醫療人才培育與擬真醫學教育之發展。

Peggy Hsieh 謝佩璇, PhD, is Professor and Assistant Dean for Educator Development at McGovern Medical School at UTHealth Houston. She earned her doctorate in Educational Psychology from The University of Texas at Austin. Her work focuses on advancing teaching effectiveness, faculty and resident development, and medical education research.

Since joining McGovern Medical School in 2009, Dr. Hsieh has designed and delivered more than 50 invited interactive workshops at national and international conferences. Her workshops emphasize practical, evidence-based approaches to teaching and learning that educators can readily apply in clinical and academic settings. Internationally requested topics include:

1. Flipping Your Classroom with In-Class Activities
2. Beliefs and How They Affect the Way We Provide and Receive Feedback: Promoting Growth Mindset
3. Understanding Learner Motivation

Dr. Hsieh is the Founder and Director of the Physician Educator Certificate Program (PECP), established in 2016 to strengthen the teaching skills of residents and fellows. This eight-month longitudinal program provides structured professional development in teaching and learning. Under her leadership, the program has graduated more than 490 participants, many of whom have gone on to academic positions across the United States and internationally.

In 2026, Dr. Hsieh founded the Physician Leader Certificate Program (PLCP), an eight-month longitudinal program designed to prepare residents and fellows for leadership roles in medicine and the healthcare workforce. The inaugural cohort includes 37 residents and fellows who are developing practical leadership skills while exploring the qualities and practices of effective leaders.

Dr. Hsieh is deeply committed to mentorship and educational collaboration. She works closely with faculty, residents, and fellows to develop innovative, evidence-informed teaching strategies, create meaningful learning experiences, and advance educational scholarship.

Biography

Dr. Akkanti joined UTHealth Houston in 2013 and is currently a Professor in the Department of Medicine and the Assistant Dean of Clinical Education at McGovern Medical School. In her role as Assistant Dean, she is dedicated to enhancing the clinical education of medical students across all McGovern Medical School campuses, striving to create consistent, high-quality, and compassionate learning experiences that prepare students for excellence in patient care.

She is a graduate of the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School. She completed her internship in Internal Medicine at Baylor College of Medicine and pursued a residency at Boston University Medical Center. She then completed her fellowship in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at Baylor College of Medicine, where she trained in critical care, lung cancer, asthma, COPD, pulmonary hypertension, cystic fibrosis, lung transplantation, and other advanced lung diseases through rotations at Ben Taub General Hospital, The Methodist Hospital, St. Luke's Hospital, and the Michael E. DeBakey Veterans Affairs Medical Center. Dr. Akkanti also completed the Clinical Scientist Training Program, conducting bioinformatics-based translational research in lung cancer under Dr. Francesco DeMayo in the Department of Molecular and Cellular Biology at Baylor College of Medicine.

Educational Roles and Activities

In her current role as Assistant Dean of Clinical Education, Dr. Akkanti oversees the clinical curriculum for third- and fourth-year medical students, working to ensure that these experiences are seamlessly aligned with the foundational education of the first two years. Her focus is on creating a cohesive, well-rounded, and mission-driven curriculum that fosters clinical excellence, professionalism, and compassion — hallmarks of the McGovern Medical School mission.

Dr. Akkanti is a faculty member in the Division of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at McGovern Medical School, where she teaches fellows, residents, and students in areas including advanced heart and lung disease, pulmonary hypertension, and mechanical circulatory support. She also serves as site director for internal medicine, vascular surgery, and emergency medicine residents rotating through the heart and lung transplant intensive care unit.

- Prior to her current leadership role, Dr. Akkanti served as the Module Co-Director for the Pulmonary Module for first-year medical students and Co-Director for the Transitions to Residency Course for fourth-year medical students. She also served for many years as the McGovern Society

Leader for the Runnels Society, mentoring students longitudinally throughout their training.

Dr. Akkanti is deeply committed to simulation-based education, particularly in teaching hemodynamics and mechanical circulatory support. She has led numerous national simulation courses across various platforms, helping to make complex cardiovascular physiology approachable for clinicians at all levels. Her goal is to meet learners where they are — cultivating confidence, curiosity, and competence through individualized and interactive learning.

Her outstanding dedication to teaching has been recognized through multiple honors, including induction into the Academy of Master Educators, the Alpha Omega Alpha (AOA) Honor Medical Society, and recognition by CHEST as a Distinguished Educator for her contributions to pulmonary and critical care education.

Biography

As an academic pediatrician, my teaching activities involve both students and residents in outpatient clinics as well as the newborn nursery. My administrative roles include serving as Residency Program Director for McGovern's categorical pediatrics residency program, as well as serving as the Assistant Dean of Clinical Education for McGovern, coordinating the third and fourth year medical student program.

Educational Philosophy

Far and away my preferred method of teaching is in small groups at the bedside of a patient. Clinical bedside teaching allows a real-time assessment of the learner's knowledge and understanding as an integral part of the teaching process. The dialog between teacher, learner and patient allows the teacher to adjust the content and style to best match the learner's abilities. I find these sessions have a more lasting impact on the learner, much more so than a large group lecture. I am happy to cede lecturing to others, while I reinforce what they learned and demonstrate its application on an actual patient. This style of teaching also allows me to contribute to the student's identity development by demonstrating effective patient communication skills as well as the professional demeanor and behavior required of a physician
